Aniquary - Benitachell

This is an Italian restaurant in the centre of Benitachell, beautifully appointed with high ceilings and a warm cosy atmosphere. There is ample on street parking outside.

The restaurant was fairly deserted on the night in question in mid October and there was no menu of the day on offer.

The menu was mainly pizza and pasta dishes with a limited number of meat and fish based dishes and a few “special” dishes.

Our party of six ordered meat and fish dishes. One the whole we were all satisfied with our choices although vegetables were in short supply. Other diners were having pizzas and pasta and all seemed happy enough.

The ambiance and location were both good with acceptable service.

Cost per person of typical main meal – 13€, pizzas from 8€

Conclusion – An “OK” restaurant but nothing to write home about.
