

## Restaurant Review by Peter Wells

### Casa Parra - Gata

Situated on the left about 100m before Masymas in the direction of Ondarra on the main road through Gata, this very Spanish style, family run restaurant offers a very wide choice on their "Menu del Dia". There is ample parking in the side roads close to the restaurant.

Casa Parra does not look too promising from the road but has a long narrow dining room with some 15 tables with rustic style tiles on the walls offering plenty of Spanish ambiance.

The Menu comprises about 8 starters including soups, mixed Hors d'Oeuvres and paella, about 8 main courses including various meats, liver (wonderful!) and various fish dishes all served with fries. There is no vegetarian option. This was followed by a great choice of sweets including double chocolate cake (to die for!). The menu also includes bread, alioli, drink and coffee – **all for 9.50€**

Our party of four enjoyed the very reasonable portions and excellent, friendly service.

Smoking is **NOT** allowed.

Conclusion – A charming dining experience, great food with excellent service.
