Fourteen of us met at this spacious restaurant in the centre of Moraira opposite the “Tu Tu” dress shop.

The restaurant was surprisingly busy for a midweek November evening and our menu had been specially negotiated due our party size.

We all were served with crisp popadums and pickle trays followed by ample portions of the mixed starters all of which were freshly prepared and delicious.

We each had chosen our individual main meals which ranged from mild to madras strength with a variety of meats and king prawns. Boiled and pilau rice were served along with ample nan bread. Irrespective of what we ordered everyone was highly delighted with their selections and all agreed we had made a great choice of venue. We could now see why this place was so popular.
