

Restaurant Review by Peter Wells

Kathmandhu - Moraira

Situated about half a kilometre outside Moraira on the Calpe road just past Gemisant this Indian restaurant had just been open for over a year. There is limited parking in their car park outside.

Two of us went for the first time and took the set menu which included mixed starters, choice of any dish on the menu except “specials and prawn dishes”, rice, plain or garlic naan, vegetable dish of the day and coffee or ice cream.

To say this was a dining disappointment was an understatement.

The restaurant is devoid of any atmosphere being far too brightly lit and without any attempt to make the ambience cosy.

Although quite busy, service was appalling taking over an hour between starter and main course. When our food did arrive it was “OK” and well presented.

The menu was dull and totally predictable. Drinks were not included and very expensive (house wine 9.50€, half litre bottle of water 2€, glass of wine 2.50€). Compared to other Indian restaurants in Moraira this is definitely third division!

Smoking is allowed and there were plenty of vegetarian options on offer as one would expect.

Cost per person 13.50€ (plus drinks)

Conclusion – Go here only as a last resort - if all other Indian restaurants are closed!
