La Naya - Benimarco

For the final outing of the 2008/9 season we combined both groups and so 36 of us descended on this hidden gem in early July. The restaurant is about 2 km from Teulada towards Benimarco on the CV-741, at the small roundabout turn right to Benissa and it is 100m on the left up a steep ramp.

We all sat out on the terrace and enjoyed beautiful panoramic views of the sea over Benimarco.

The restaurant had composed a special menu for us and every selection on each course (including a vegetarian option) was super and included loads of fresh vegetables (we counted a choice of eight). The menu included half a bottle of wine, water, bread & ali oli, all for €14.

The staff were all super and we all enjoyed this splendid finale to the “season”

Sue & I had visited La Naya before and they offer a 2 course midweek lunchtime menu for €8, a super Sunday lunch of 3 courses & wine for €13. The normal menu del dia in the evening including wine is €16.
