

Restaurant Review by Peter Wells

La Pista - Jalon

Situated right in the heart of Jalon on Calle Inglesia, this restaurant has as its chef, Mike Yaffe, who used to own the L'Almacera restaurant in Teulada with his late wife.

We arrived in a group of 9 for Sunday lunch. The dining room was very well decorated and the tables were beautifully laid along with very comfortable chairs.

We selected from the Sunday lunch menu of the day which consisted of a great selection of all courses including (amongst others) a lovely prawn, tuna and crab cocktail or deep fried brie and for main courses (amongst others) roast beef, chefs pie, pork medallions in mushroom sauce or confit of duck. Main courses were served with a (small) plate of vegetables to share and beautiful roast potatoes.

Sweets were equally varied and original. The meal was accompanied by bread & ali oli and one (rather mean) glass of wine or small beer or water.

The food was beautifully cooked and presented and portions were good (except for the vegetables – we had to ask for more!). Service was very attentive too. For reservations call 966 480 125
