

Restaurant Review by Peter Wells

Las Vegas - Teulada

Situated right opposite the town hall square in Teulada the Las Vegas does not look too promising from outside but appearances can be deceptive and our party had an excellent night there.

On entering the restaurant you find a very Spanish bar and some dining tables for smokers. The backroom is the main dining room which is totally non smoking! The decoration is a bit dated but very Spanish in style.

The menu of the day comprises a selection of some 10 starters including Chipperones, melon with ham, prawn cocktail, croquettes, Hawaiian salad etc. Main courses are divided into three price groups. The 14€ menu includes salmon, chicken in port sauce, pork cordon bleu, paella etc. The 17€ menu included swordfish, hake in garlic sauce etc and the 20€ menu included steak in Roquefort cheese sauce. Our diners had main courses from all menu categories and all were delighted with their selection, irrespective of price.

The menu included a selection from the sweet menu including crème Catalan, ice cream, chocolate mousse etc or coffee. Half a bottle of wine or a soft drink was also included as was bread and ali oli.

The service was both attentive and cheerful. In the summer tables are available in the square itself and your food is brought to the tables over the zebra crossing outside!
