Meson de Paco – Benitachell/Javea

This was the first meeting of the U3A dining out “B” group and 12 of us met at this restaurant about one Km past the entrance to Javea Golf Club on the Javea road.

The restaurant is well appointed with very attentive staff. Seating is both inside and outside under a covered terrace. There was ample off street parking.

This was a last minute replacement for the Monte Video who had decided to close for holidays on that day and had transferred our booking (having called us first) to Paco’s. Nobody in our party had been to Paco’s before although we had all driven past it numerous times.

The “Menu del Dia” was limited to three choices per course but, irrespective of choice, the quality and quantity was very good indeed. There were plenty of other diners who filled up the tables inside.

The ambiance and location were very good and it was hard to find fault.

Cost per person 20€ - 3 courses, coffee and seemingly unlimited house wine etc
