

## Restaurant Review by Peter Wells

### **DGUST – Moraira**

Dgust is situated right in the heart of Moraira a few metres behind the bronze figures. Six of us visited on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> September.

The restaurant is beautifully appointed with very attentive staff. Seating was both inside and outside on beautifully presented linen tablecloths etc. When we visited Dgust it was mostly empty. The menu was well presented and offered a very creative assortment of unusual dishes including “Kids leg”, Pork medallions, Seafood and various other meat dishes . A sorbet was served between the starter and main courses. There was no “menu del dia”.

Everyone in our party enjoyed their meals and the service was excellent. Unfortunately the restaurant was badly let down by both the lack of customers and subsequent ambiance and also by the exorbitant prices charged. The portions were barely “adequate” but there is no way that the prices could be justified. Far better value for money can be found elsewhere.

Cost per person 45€ - 3 courses and house wine etc

Conclusion – great for a special occasion provided somebody else is paying!
