Los Almendros – Javea/Jesus Pobre

Just on the right about three Kms from Javea on the road to Jesus Pobre right under Montgo and right opposite the well known “Montgo Restaurant” is the large spacious Los Almendros restaurant with its very large car park. Eighteen of us met, ate and drank there on a warm sunny evening in mid May.

We were presented with the “menu del dia” which offered a huge selection of both familiar and more unusual courses plus extra “specials of the day” which on the night included a sea food salad starter and slow cooked lamb. Quite frankly the choice was amazing! There is no bar area so we had to sit down at our tables rather than enjoy a social drink together before the meal.

Unlike the majority of local restaurants at the moment, every table was taken and diners without bookings were being turned away at the door.

The meal started with a small “taster” dish of cauliflower soup which was a nice touch. Every one of us enjoyed our meals, whatever we had chosen. The service was excellent and the meals were super quality and quantity.

Smoking is not allowed in the restaurant and vegetarian options were available.

The normal menu of the day includes three courses and bread & ali oli, and half a bottle of wine, and coffee, and IVA, all for the amazing price of 14€.
