General History

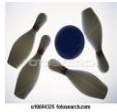
Here is the new programme for the 2009/10 season. The talks will take place in the lecture theatre of the Espai la Senieta building in central Moraira.

The first one, given by Angela Chantry, will be on Monday 28 September at 10am. Entitled '*The Wonderful Adventures of Mrs. Mary Seacole*', it will be based on her autobiography and cover Mary's life from childhood in Jamaica, her travels, and her decision to join Florence Nightingale in the Crimea. It will conclude with her post-war experiences, her descent into obscurity and the recent revival of interest in this remarkable woman. The talk will last about 75 minutes.

Two further talks are scheduled for Monday 26 October and Monday 30th November, both starting at 10 am. They will be part of a six talk series by Cedomira Panajotovic covering the interactive history of Spain, Britain and the Mediterranean area generally.
