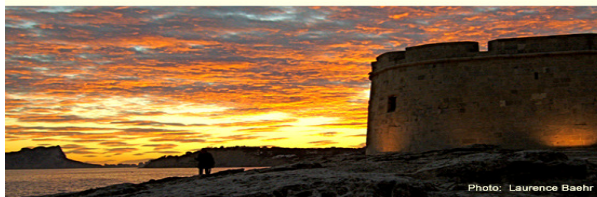

I am delighted to tell you that the arrangements are now finalised for the Montgo Chorale to sing to us on the 5 October, please come along and enjoy the music this very well known choir will be making for us.

As I mentioned last month, November will be our AGM and we will also be having Guest Speakers from the Consulate in Alicante. They will include Martyn Standing from the Department of Work and Pensions. Some of you may remember Martyn from the presentation that was held in Espai la Senieta in April. Martyn has kindly agreed to

come along with Consulate colleagues and answer any questions which Members may have. It would be an enormous help if those of you with questions would let me know what they are (by email through my link on the website or to 965747343) so that I can tell Martyn. If they know in advance what the questions will be, it means they can ensure that they either bring the right people with them, or get the answers to the questions before they come. So far I have only had one question given to me.

The Annual General Meeting and the elections are an important part of our U3A, and this year is especially important as one of our key Committee members will be unable to stand for election again due to other commitments. Graham Simons has been a wonderfully effective and focused Treasurer, but he does not have the time to continue in this post. The post of Treasurer is without doubt the most important one in the U3A, and it is essential that someone comes forward to volunteer for the job. Graham has said that he will give his replacement a thorough explanation of what he does, and how he does it, so will anyone who feels they may be able to do the job, please contact me and I will put them in touch with Graham.

The current Committee was elected in November 2008 for a year. The elections for the four principal positions of President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary, and the rest of the Committee will all take place in November. At that time the main current post holders will stand down, but they may if they wish seek re-election via the nomination procedure. The President and Vice President will seek re-election, the Treasurer will stand down, and the post of Secretary is currently vacant.

Painting: Watercolour Techniques

See the Table below for the materials list for those just signed up. Drawing boards will do about size A5 for starters. The ferreteria will cut you a couple very cheaply, but they need to be plywood.

MATERIALS FOR PAINTING WITH WATERCOLOUR

Pencils 2B or 3B

Brushes –Sable or animal hair Nos 6 and 10 Round

Sharpener

Large Flat wash brush

Putty Rubber

Watercolour paper NOT (hot pressed), small pad to begin with 190gsm block is useful

Gumstrip for stretching paper on drawing board (essential)

I have a small quantity for sale

Drawing boards or plywood (ferreteria will cut you a couple very cheaply)

Sketchbook A4 or A5 cartridge paper

Two large jam jars

Toilet roll or tissues

Soft cloth

Palette or white saucers, plates etc.

Small natural sponge

Masking fluid

*Initial starter paints - Cadmium Red Alizarin Crimson Cadmium Yellow Lemon Yellow
Cobalt Blue Ultramarine Burnt Sienna Raw Sienna
Burnt Umber Raw Umber Paynes Grey*

The art shop I use is MATICES, Denia near the Mercadona. Park in Mercadona's car park and go through the shop and out at the front door. Turn right across the road, past the next block, turn right and you will see the art shop on the left hand side, less than a hundred yards on. The phone number is 965 783 278 if your Spanish is good. The proprietor does speak a little English and is quite helpful. Let her know that you are in the Moraira/Teulada U3A as if she thinks we are to keep coming, we can perhaps get a discount.

Your class begins at 10am until 12.30 on Wednesday 16 Sept. To get here from Benitachell go past Javea Golf, the pizza restaurant, the garden center and turn off left at the old stone cross on to Cami vell de Teulada. At the dustbins turn right and we are the third house on the left, number 17.

We have a casita that is now an art studio with a separate toilet. We have coffee and tea making facilities, a sink for washing palettes etc and this year we have a shelf system for bags so as to save space. We have fans in the summer and gas central heating in the winter, so it is a comfortable and creative atmosphere. I will ask for three euros per

person to cover expenses such as utilities, refreshments and the inevitable use of my materials when necessary.

Last term we spent some time drawing and painting at the Albarda gardens at La Sella. However, at the start of the course we will concentrate on mastering the basic techniques including the pursuit of good drawing which is essential for the maker of a good painting.

May I draw your attention to next Thursday's 17th Sept. NEW Art Appreciation class now to be at the MABS centre in Benitachell from 4pm until 6pm. Essential to building on your knowledge of how Art has developed through time, and differed in places, if you are aiming to be an good artist yourself.

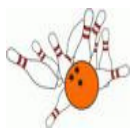
Petanque
