



Dalmau is on Avenida Mediterraneo the main dual carriageway in Teulada opposite Bar Mediterraneo. It was formerly an Italian restaurant and the new(ish) Spanish owners come from Javea. Thirty of the dining group gathered on the worst night of the year and were very pleased to have made the effort. The menu is extensive, often not a good sign, but in this case everything was cooked and presented beautifully. Cost for three courses with wine and water, depended on main course price, ranging from chicken and cordon blue at 13 euros to duck and steak at 19. Everyone I spoke to had nothing but praise, a rare occurrence! Our group occupied the back part of the restaurant, and it says a lot that on such a foul night the other part was buzzing, mostly I think with Spanish.
