On the 22nd May 2012, 26 members of the Barcelona Group met at the Indian Palace Restaurant, which is located in Calle Tosqueres in the centre of Moraira, just opposite Pepe la Sal supermarket.

Although the restaurant is very spacious, it had a welcoming atmosphere and we were all greeted by our hosts for the evening, Eileen and David Haxon.

The tables were arranged so the whole of the party were able to sit in one area together and we were soon served Poppadums and trays of chutneys/relishes while our drinks were being ordered.

All diners had pre-selected their choices from a menu consisting of 5 starters, 6 mains, 2 side dishes and 5 desserts. 4 of the main dishes offered a variety of chicken, lamb, beef or king prawn. All mains were served with Basmati Rice and Naan bread. The staff were cheerful and friendly and all diners were served their courses at about the same time.

The specially negotiated price of €16 included one drink and a tip and was considered to be good value for money.

Location, service and ambiance were excellent and everyone I spoke to thoroughly enjoyed their meal.
