

LA ISLA RESTAURANT REVIEW OCTOBER 2012

La Isla is a Persian restaurant just off the Calpe road out of Moraira on the right opposite Pollo Loco. Two separate groups of 30 people dined at La Isla in October. The earlier group had warm enough weather to dine outside, but for the second group it was chilly and we were inside.



Both surroundings were pleasant and the service was very attentive. Starters were good, although a bit sparse on the prawns for the seafood cocktail. For the main course most people seemed to have chosen the lamb which was excellent, and all the desserts were good, especially the crème brulee. We paid 20 euros all in which appears to be the regular price, with occasional Persian themed special events. It got a definite thumbs up from the people I spoke to.
