

MICHETA RESTAURANT MORAIRA SEPTEMBER 2012

Micheta restaurant is situated above Ifach Golf Club with wonderful views towards the coast and the Peñon de Ifach, Calpe Rock.



Two tranches of the dining out group visited on two different occasions, the first set dining out on the terrace, the second in the sheltered interior courtyard. On the first occasion the food was a little variable depending on choice, for example the starter baked Camembert was substantial, the melon and ham very sparse. Most people seemed happy with their main course, especially those who had the entrecote which was excellent. But the service was very slow and not very efficient. But for the second and much larger group, these faults had been rectified, and the group were all very happy with the meal.

Our groups had a specially negotiated rate of 20 euros for three courses and a half bottle of wine, but the normal price is substantially more than that. I have also recently been there for an organised barbecue for a big golf group, which was done very well.

To sum up, the setting is delightful, the food is mostly very good, but at the moment the service unpredictable and the prices are quite high. One to watch.
