

Restaurant Review by Peter Wells

Restaurante Puerto - Javea

Although outside the “patch” I have included a review based on value for money and quality alone. A group of 4 of us visited in late January and again in early February.

Located in Javea the restaurant is run by very friendly Dutch owners and has a splendid position right on the sea front at the end of the bay by the port.

On offer is a “Crisis Menu del Dia” comprising 3 courses, bread and ali oli available at lunch and dinner times. Starters include salad or cream of vegetable soup followed by pork chops, spare ribs or fish in blue cheese sauce and finally a choice of sweets. On Wednesdays Lamb is also available. On the day we went Lasagne was also on offer as a main course.

All the food was excellent quality and quantity –

but the best part was the price – **4.95€**

Of course drinks were extra and not cheap (water was 1.75€/half litre and a small beer 2.50€)

The location, service and ambiance were first class.

The “crisis menu” is only available till the end of February but the owners assured me that they would have other low cost offers from March onwards – to find out just call them on 965 791 064, they all speak English!

Conclusion – Wonderful value in these hard times and amazing quality too!
