Message from the President

Again, he had ID and neighbours names. However, we only have two neighbours and

they hadn't given anything to him. I asked someone from the Ayuntamiento about him and she said that Spanish charities NEVER come round houses. The next time he came we told him what she had said, and suggested that he not call on us, or anyone in our area again, or we would call the police. Interestingly, he very politely said "thank you and goodbye!" Again, please be on your guard against this sort of thing. I suppose any day now we'll start to get the bogus gas men coming round too! Last year we had one who came to the house; I took the phone out with me and pretended to take a picture of his very beat up van. He started ranting and raving at me and said he would be back to kill me, so, call it instinct, but I think perhaps he wasn't a genuine gas man!

And so to something more cheerful, we are literally days away from the celebration for the 5th Anniversary of the founding of Moraira Teulada U3A. The subcommittee have worked incredibly hard to make sure you have a good time, and I would like to thank them all for their time and efforts. Please remember to bring your picnics etc, and also to tidy up around "your" area before you go home. We are so lucky to have Font Santa as a venue, and how pretty it is now that the trees they planted 6 years ago have grown enough to give us shade, but please remember at that time of the day the sun can be quite strong. I do hope you all have a wonderful time, and a day to remember, and I look forward to seeing some of your photos.
